

THE ETERNAL HIMALAYAS: BHUTAN & NEPAL

VINTGAR GORGE, SLOVENIA STAY: KEMPINKSI PALACE PORTOROZ

Along the northern border of Slovenia, just at the edge of Triglav National Park, is a scenic walkway along the historic Vintgar Gorge. Here, the mile long Scaffold Trail is considered an engineering masterpiece, winding down between 300 foot canyon walls as it drops to a total of 1,000 feet, ending at an incredible cascade called Sum Falls. Approximately 15 minutes south of the gorge is Lake Bled (pictured above), one of Slovenia's most famous attractions where you can swim in natural pools, kayak, or even take a gondola ride to the castle. If you're looking to diversify your experience, we suggest heading to the stunning Adriatic coastline to stay at Kempinski Palace Portoroz, a short two hour drive away.






EASTER ISLAND, CHILE STAY: EXPLORA RAPA NUI
